PARADE REGULATIONS

- † As street turns in Lakeview are narrow and overhead space is limited, there will be no large floats (truck floats, etc.) allowed in the parade. Military vehicles, motorcycles, Shriner buggies, convertibles, fire trucks, police wagons, etc. are all acceptable.
- † The Veterans Day Parade is *not* a Carnival parade. *Nothing* shall be thrown from Parade entries to crowd. *There are no exceptions to this rule.* Any entrant wishing to distribute anything to parade attendees may do so by handing out items.
- † Any handouts from any Parade entrant should have a patriotic message or theme. Candy or treats for children being an exception.
- † All handouts shall be approved by Lakeview Veterans, LLC prior to November 2nd.
- † Parade participants under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
- † This parade is about the celebration of our men and women who have served and/or are currently serving in our nation's Armed Forces. The focus should be on them. Political promotion of any kind in the parade other than loaning of items like tents shall not be allowed, nor will any parade participants be allowed to hand out any political paraphernalia. We definitely welcome any and all political candidates to take out sponsorships and make donations, and they shall be recognized accordingly.
- † All parade entrants should have a Military or Patriotic theme. All vehicles that are not military should display at least one American Flag or flag of a branch of the Service. All vehicles shall have at least one Veteran or Veteran-related participant.
- † The men and women who served and who continue to serve this country did so and do so under the Flag of the United States of America and the flags of their respective services. Any other flag of any type in the parade not receiving prior approval by the committee will not be tolerated, and those who violate this rule will be removed.
